### Coding for NAS



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- Term infant born to a mother with maternal OUD, on suboxone, develops symptoms and signs of withdrawal at 3 days of life. Finnegan scores consistently above 10 that day. Treated with morphine dosing tapered over the next 10 days and discharged home on DOL 15.
- Term infant born to a mother with maternal OUD, on suboxone, develops symptoms and signs of withdrawal at 3 days of life. Noted to respond to non-pharm interventions including swaddling, kangaroo care with mom and breastfeeding. Infant moved to a single patient room on the pediatric floor where mom can room in. Nurses noting that eat, sleep and console criteria are satisfied with non-pharm measures being used. Baby discharged at 9 days of life with mom.



#### Coding Neonatal Withdrawal Syndrome

- The current ICD-10 code\* for NAS is P96.1, Neonatal withdrawal symptoms from maternal use of drugs of addiction.
- Clinical Information
  - A constellation of signs and symptoms observable in a neonate that are consistent with maternal substance abuse or withdrawal while pregnant.
  - Fetal and neonatal addiction and withdrawal as a result of the mother's dependence on drugs during pregnancy.
  - Withdrawal or abstinence symptoms develop shortly after birth. Symptoms exhibited are loud, high-pitched crying, sweating, yawning and gastrointestinal disturbances.
- This does not include newborns that are withdrawing from opioids or other substances that were given after birth for treatment.
- All NAS diagnoses should also include a diagnosis of substance exposure to at least one substance in utero.

#### Diagnosing NAS

- Florida Criteria for chart review
  - 1. evidence of maternal use of opioids, benzodiazepines, or barbiturates
  - 2. presence of ≥1 infant withdrawal signs related to NAS
  - 3. birth hospitalization length of stay >3 days
