**Study Description:** Purpose:A leading cause of maternal mortality in North Carolina is unrecognized cardiac conditions leading to a cardiac related mortality. This project will spread established best practices for screening, identification and escalation of care to proper specialists. Participants: Inpatient maternal delivery services in the state of North Carolina.

Procedures (methods): PQCNC using the AIM (Alliance for Innovation in Maternal Health) Cardiac Care Bundle will deploy a statewide action plan to reduce the impact of cardiac conditions on maternal mortality in North Carolina.
